Chuck Johns seconded the motion on the condition that GVMA submit the two McCully Landscape invoices to Keller Engineers for reimbursement of the booster pumps installed in 3 homes on Church Hill Road. - E. Jim Krause made a motion to approve the August treasurer's report showing a balance of \$227,882.05. Tom Roles seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members voted aye. Motion passed.
- F. Rick Gates made a motion to approve Change Order #2 on Contract 1 in the amount of \$5,600.00. Tom Roles seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members voted aye. Motion passed.
- G. Tom Roles made a motion to table a motion to approve Requisition S13 in the amount of \$14,628.24. Chuck Johns seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.

- A. John Krise asked about Potutschnig's water pressure on Church Hill Road, and wanted to know if the customers who received the booster pumps were still losing water. He also asked if GVMA employees could take work trucks home when it was their weekend to work. The employees can't do that. He also asked about restoration of his property on Fiske Road. Tom Hollis made a motion to get a price on fixing the Krise property. Rick Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- B. Jim Luther asked if we have someone that can mark lines for his son's newly constructed home since we don't have a GIS Specialist. John Patrick will mark the lines/taps.

Chuck Johns made a motion to end the meeting at 9:20 p.m. Rick Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
