- E. Rick Gates made a motion to approve Requisition #S8 in the amount of \$27,248.51. Thurman Keifer seconded the motion. . A vote was taken . Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineer's. Tom Hollis voted nay. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- F. Tom Hollis made a motion to approve Pennvest reimbursement request #W4 in the amount of \$47,452.50. Rick Gates seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineer's. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- G. Rick Gates made a motion to approve Pennvest reimbursement request #S2 in the amount of \$131,424.55. Jim Krause seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment with Keller Engineer's. All other board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
- H. Rick Gates made a motion to approve Keller Engineer's preparing the NPDES permit application at a cost of \$1,800.00. Thurman Keifer seconded the motion. There was no public comment. A vote was taken. Tom Roles abstained due to his employment at Keller Engineers. Tom Hollis voted nay. All other board members voted aye. Motion passed.
- Tom Hollis makes a motion to credit Mr. Freiwald one months billing for interrupting their water service. Rick Gates seconded the motion. Marylou Walker asked if we had credited the accounts for customers with frozen lines. A vote was taken. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.

General Public Comment

- A. Zane Hullihen said nothing was mentioned during the meeting regarding the RTMA water rate as discussed in the executive session. He proposed \$4.93/per 1000 gallons without the declining rate as stated in the water purchase agreement.
- B. Christian Gohn said that on the Receipts & Disbursements there is a deposit reimbursing GVMA for Tracy's UPMC health insurance. There is also an expense paying Tracy's insurance. He also said that the Glendale Yearound developer installed lines incorrectly, and they need replaced.
- C. Marylou Walker stated that the public pays Bill Barbins salary and that he interfered with a question she had asked the engineer. She said Bill Barbin is at the meeting's for legal advice. She also stated that the restoration near the cannon hadn't been completed. Kirk McCully said he will be finishing it as weather permits.
- D. John Krise wanted to know if the posts on Red Oak Road are for meter readings. He asked if we would put anything around them to protect them. He also asked about the tap fee payment that is due to RTMA for the Glendale Yearound interconnection. He wanted to know if rates would increase again to cover that cost.

Tom Hollis made a motion to adjourn the GVMA board meeting at 9:15 PM. Rick Gates seconded the motion. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed.
